



## NOTICE DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS)

### Steel Lake Park to Downtown Trail Project

**Proposal:** The intent of this project is to widen S 312<sup>th</sup> St. to construct a bike lane and sidewalk on the South side from 24<sup>th</sup> Ave. S. to 28<sup>th</sup> Ave. S. (approximately 1,300 feet) and new channelization from 23<sup>rd</sup> Ave. S. to 28<sup>th</sup> Ave. S. (approximately 1,650 feet). Also included is curb and gutter, planter strip, illumination, retaining walls, and ADA handicap ramps.

You should be prepared to make specific factual objections
