The City of Federal Way wants to help your business recycle!

FREE Recycling Service



- All businesses within the City of Federal Way limits with commercial garbage service are eligible for up to two free 96-gallon recycling carts, collected weekly.
- Includes businesses that share garbage service and individual businesses located within a business park or commercial building.
- Recycle cardboard, mixed paper, plastic bottles/jugs/cups, glass bottles/jars and metal cans—all in the same cart.

FREE Recycling Containers

- Free desk-side recycling containers when you start or improve your recycling program (*limit 5, while supplies last*).
- Signs and stickers with photos of what can and cannot be recycled to place on recycling containers.

Sign up for compost collection today!

Many items thrown away in lunchrooms or kitchens can be composted, including:

- **Food trimmings/scrap**
Fruits, vegetables, meat, bones, & coffee grounds/filters.
- **Food-soiled paper**
Napkins, paper towels, pizza boxes, & uncoated paper plates.
- **Plants and flowers**

Compost collection includes:

- Weekly compost collection (96-gallon cart) starting at less than \$10 per month.
- Free interior compost collection containers and posters.
- Free assistance and staff training.
