

2016-17 Federal Way Garbage and Yard Waste Rates

(Rates effective March 1, 2016 thru February 28, 2017)



Preventing waste shrinks garbage and can lower your rates.

HERE'S HOW:

- Use the blue cart for **ALL RECYCLABLE** items (cans, bottles, paper, cardboard and more!)
- **YARD/FOOD WASTE** is collected separately and processed into compost. This weekly service costs less than disposing yard/food waste as garbage. Do not put yard/food waste into your curbside recycling cart.
- Think before you buy
 - Can this item – or its packaging – be recycled?
 - Can I buy it in bulk?
 - Can I choose a durable or reusable item instead of a disposable one?

(2) 32-gal cans or (1) 64-gal green WM cart	\$26.26
(3) 32-gal cans or (1) 96-gal green WM cart	\$35.14
(1) extra 32-gal can/equivalent	\$ 6.16 ea.

Recycling Service Every Other Week	
(1) 64-gal blue WM recycling cart	included
(1) 96-gal blue WM recycling cart	included

Extra Recycling: Remember – there is no charge for setting out extra recycling.

- Use a cardboard box(es) or a durable container(s) marked “recycling” (32-gal limit) if you run out of room in your cart.
- You can also upgrade for free to a 96-gal cart if you need more volume.

Extra 96-gal cans/bags or equivalent	\$ 5.77 ea.
Clean/deodorize cart	\$10.00 ea.

Rates vary by size

(the smaller the container, the lower the rate).

Waste Management provides all container sizes except 32-gallon cans, which customers must purchase and maintain.

Waste Management bills quarterly (every three months). This helps keep costs lower by saving on paper, postage and time.
