It will be located along the east side of 28th Ave S., just north of S. 312th St, scheduled to be completed in early 2026. "This is 100-year infrastructure that has been 20 years in the making. I believe that our hard-working Public Works and Parks Operations Teams, as well as our community, deserve this state-of-the-art facility to provide quality street maintenance, parks mowing, stormwater operations, snow and ice operations, and emergency response," said Mayor Ferrell. 


